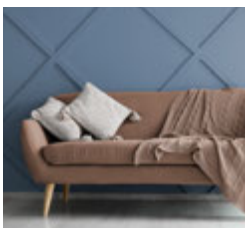
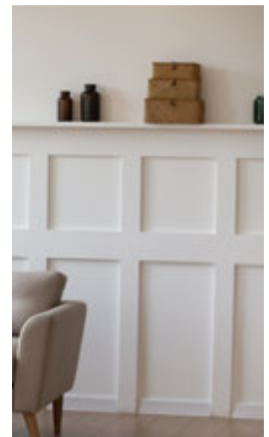
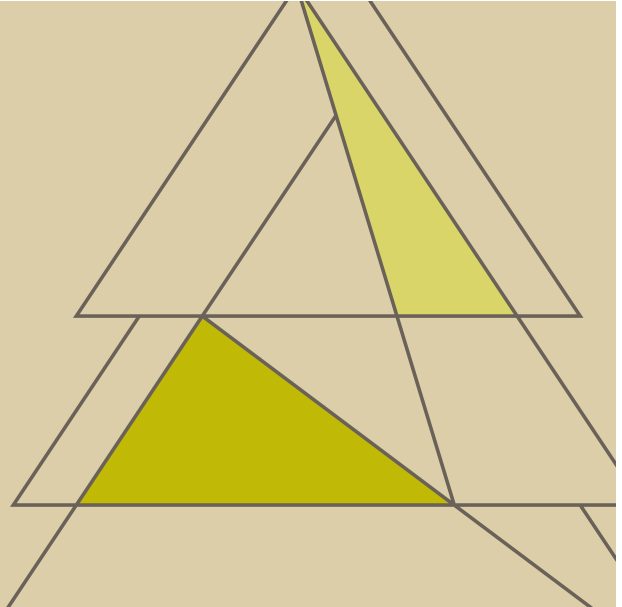

WORLD-CLASS SUSTAINABILITY STRATEGY



Our industry is at the center of the transition to a sustainable economy. Trees are the ultimate renewable resource, and forestry products can capture and store CO₂. Wood is fifty percent carbon by weight. This carbon is stored, not just in trees, but in the products fabricated from their wood. Carbon stored in this fashion cannot contribute to greenhouse gas emissions unless the forests or the derived wood products decay or are burned.

As the first forestry company to be certified carbon neutral, our sustainability strategy focuses on balancing responsible forestry management with sustainable production. In fact, by virtue of our forestland and our renewable products, we are more than carbon neutral. We offset more emissions than we create. In 2023 alone, we offset 7.2 million more tons of carbon than were emitted by our operations.

The company has been certified as carbon neutral since 2020, being the first

forest products company to achieve this certification. Today, we are taking this commitment one step further by joining the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi).

ARAUCO has committed to further reducing its emissions by approximately 1.5 million tons of CO₂ by 2030, joining global efforts to limit the global temperature increase to 1.5°C as prescribed by the United Nations Global Compact and climate action initiatives.

RESPONSIBLE FORESTRY

ARAUCO has 4.2 million acres of sustainably managed forestland and plantations in Chile, Brazil, Argentina, and Uruguay. More than a third of our heritage forestland - 1.2 million acres - is native forests. ARAUCO is the steward and protector of these native forests. We monitor and protect these prized conservation areas. We work to preserve biodiversity, to protect endangered species, and enact a comprehensive fire prevention and control strategy.

BIOFOREST

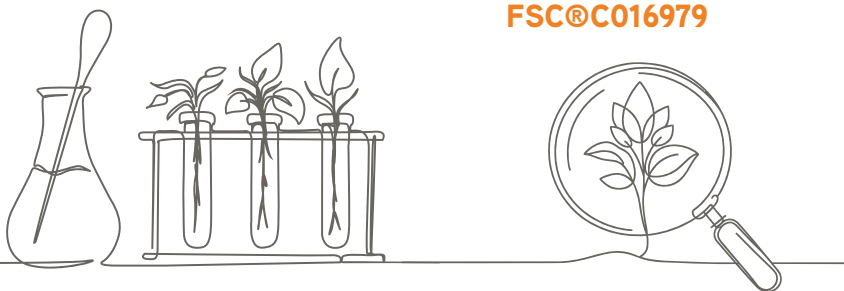
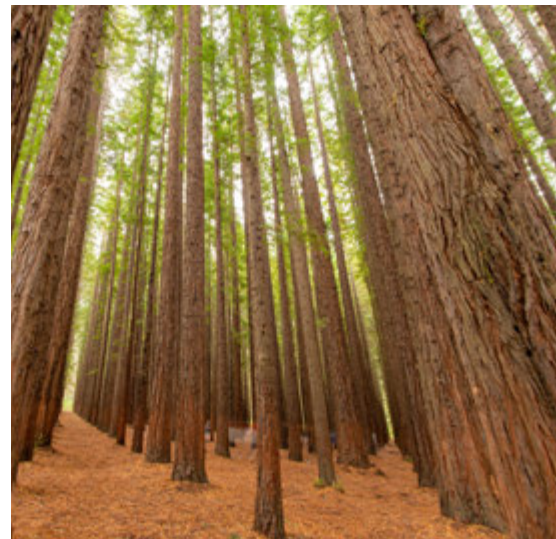
Research and development are essential to ensure that our forestlands thrive over the long term. To do so, we created Bioforest, a Center of Excellence that conducts research, and develops and applies the latest technologies at the center's labs and greenhouses, as well as the company's forestland and industrial facilities.

ETHICAL RAW MATERIALS SOURCING

ARAUCO products that are manufactured in South America use wood grown in the company's own certified, sustainably managed plantation forests. Most of our forestland across South America - nearly 4 million acres - is certified compliant with the rigorous standards of the internationally recognized Forest Stewardship Council®. *

Products we manufacture in North America are made from wood fiber that is sourced from underutilized wood from the forest floor, as well as post-industrial sawmill and manufacturing wood fiber. These residuals are collected and used in processes to make composite panels made using wood fiber that is 100% recycled and/or recovered, and/or FSC® certified (FSC®-C019364). *
