Considering that environmental protection and the occupational health and safety of company employees and contract workers are necessary conditions for the sustainable development of its activities, ARAUCO North America has made the following commitments:

- 1. Comply** with legislation and other agreements involving the environment and occupational health and safety in company workplaces, activities, products, and services.
- 2. Continuously improve** environmental, health and safety performance with Top Management engagement in setting the framework for establishment of Objectives and Targets.
- 3. Reduce** occupational health and safety risks by identification and elimination of workplace hazards through Key Corporate Operational Standards: Working at Height, Isolation and Lock Out Tag Out of Systems with Energy, Safeguarding Machinery and Equipment, Mobile Equipment, Work in Confined Spaces, and Fire Prevention.
- 4. Reduce** environmental impact through responsible energy management, sourcing of sustainably managed raw materials, and operational efficiencies.
- 5. Prevent** accidents, work related illnesses, and environmental pollution resulting from company working conditions, activities, products, and/or services.
- 6. Ensure** all ARAUCO employees and contract workers receive adequate training to fulfill their obligations, promote their consultation and participation, and provide the means for them to work with a safe, responsible attitude towards the environment, occupational health, and safety.
- 7. Notify staff**, service providing companies, relevant suppliers and other interested parties of these commitments.

All personnel working at ARAUCO are responsible for complying with and enforcing this Environmental and Occupational Health and Safety Policy, keeping it in mind throughout their daily decisions and demeanor at work.
